



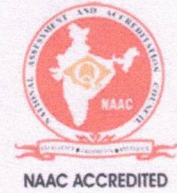

- a. The library's collection has been expanded, and access to digital resources has been increased.


Conclusion:
