


# **Analysis and Report of the Questionnaire**

1.How would you rate the overall curriculum at VJIM in terms of relevance to industry requirements and current trends?





2.How would you rate the infrastructure and facilities at VJIM, including classrooms, computer labs, library, sports facilities, and student common areas?





3. How do you rate the applicability/relevance to real life situations of the course?



4. Your opinion on depth of the course content.




Students have generally rated the depth of course content as Good to Very Good, indicating that the curriculum covers subjects with adequate depth to facilitate meaningful learning outcomes.

Students have mixed opinions about the activities offered at VJIM. While some


rate them positively, others believe there is room for improvement in terms of the variety and scope of extracurricular activities.

Most students rate the curriculum as Good to Excellent in terms of relevance to industry requirements and current trends.


7.Engagement and effectiveness of teaching methodologies employed by the faculty members.



Most students rate the teaching methodologies employed by faculty members as


Good to Very Good. This indicates that the faculty is effective in engaging students in the learning process.

8.Development of practical skills, such as problem-solving and critical thinking, through the curriculum.




Most students believe that the curriculum at VJIM helps in developing practical skills, such as problem-solving and critical thinking. The ratings for this aspect range from Good to Excellent.

9. Availability and accessibility of academic resources, such as library materials, online databases, and study materials.




Students are generally satisfied with the availability and accessibility of academic resources, such as library materials, online databases, and study materials, with ratings ranging from Good to Excellent.




#### Summary of the Feedback

2. The objectives of the syllabus are well-defined.




Most of the faculty members have agreed or strongly agreed that the syllabus objectives are well-defined for all subjects except MC and QTM.



3. The curriculum is balanced regarding the theoretical and practical knowledge.


Most faculty members for different subjects agree that the curriculum is balanced regarding theoretical and practical knowledge.

4.Contents of the curriculum are as per the industry requirement.




The majority of faculty members for all subjects agree or strongly agree that the contents of the curriculum are as per the industry requirement.

5. Course content is followed by corresponding reference materials.




For most subjects, the faculty members agree or strongly agree that the course content is followed by corresponding reference materials.

6.Infrastructural facilities required for the curriculum are available in the college.




Most faculty members for all subjects strongly agree that the infrastructural facilities required for the curriculum are available in the college.

7. The college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading skills and qualifications.




Faculty members for all subjects have strongly agreed that the college provides adequate opportunities and support to upgrade skills and qualifications.

8. The depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes.




Most faculty members agree or strongly agree that the depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes for all subjects.

## Objective


Alumni, having experienced the curriculum firsthand during their time at the college, can provide valuable insights into the relevance of the courses in the context of real-world scenarios and industry demands.


## ANALYSIS REPORT OF QUESTIONNAIRE

1. How would you rate the curriculum at VJIM?





2. How would you rate the teaching quality at VJIM?



3. How would you rate the infrastructure and facilities at VJIM.



4. How would you rate the placement support provided by VJIM


Alumni feedback on placement support varied, with some considering it to be good, while others expressed disappointment and suggested the need for more placement opportunities, especially from reputed MNCs.



5. How would you rate the overall learning experience at VJIM?


The overall learning experience at VJIM was positively rated by most alumni, with many considering it to be good or excellent.

6. How would you rate the relevance of the curriculum in preparing you for the industry?





7. How would you rate the depth of knowledge provided in the curriculum?




with some alumni considering it fair or poor, while others rated it good or excellent.

8. How would you rate the support provided by the administrative staff during your time at VJIM?




The support provided by the administrative staff received varied responses, with some alumni rating it positively, and others expressing the need for more focus on student placement and assistance.


#### Objectives



1. Please rate the academic performance of the graduates from our college:




Most respondents rated the academic performance of the graduates as above average to excellent.

2. How well do our graduates demonstrate the knowledge and skills necessary for their respective fields?




Majority responses are 'very well' and this indicates that the graduates are demonstrating the knowledge and skills necessary for their respective fields.

3. How satisfied are you with the overall academic curriculum offered by our college?





3. Please rate the quality of the faculty and their teaching methods





5. How effectively does our college prepare graduates for the demands of the industry?





6. In your experience, do graduates from this college possess strong theoretical knowledge and practical skills?





7. Are the facilities and resources provided by the college satisfactory for promoting a conducive learning environment?




The college's facilities and resources were generally rated as satisfactory and above average for promoting a conducive learning environment. This indicates that the college provides adequate support for students' educational needs.

8. please rate the overall ambience and atmosphere of our college:




